#### ~CINNAMON APPLE COFFEE CAKE~

-1 Egg

-1/3 Cup Sugar

- -1 Cup sifted all-purpose flour
- -1 Tablespoon baking powder
- -1/2 Teaspoon salt
- -1/2 Cup milk

- -1 Cup rolled oats (quick or old-fashioned, uncooked)
- -1/4 Cup shortening, melted
- -2 Large apples, peeled & sliced

Beat egg and sugar together until creamy. Mix and sift flour, baking powder and salt; add alternately with milk to egg mixture. Stir in oats and shortening. Spread half the batter in greased 9-inch round baking pan. Arrange apple slices over batter. Spread remaining batter over apple slices. Sprinkle topping over batter. Bake at 375 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes. Serve hot.

#### ~Topping~

-1/4 Cup sugar

-1/4 Teaspoon nutmeg

-1/2 Teaspoon cinnamon

-2 Tablespoons butter,

melted

Combine sugar, cinnamon, and nutmeg. Add butter, mixing well.
